This dressing uses the same materials and technology as HemCon's other dressings which are used by the military and emergency medicine professionals to control severe bleeding. Designed to be custom fitted, this dressing is used for a multitude of oral wounds including: palatal and gingival grafts, extractions and other oral surgeries.

"This product is a follow-up to our already successful Dental Dressing that is designed primarily to address the extraction market," stated HemCon, Inc. President and Chief Executive Officer, John W. Morgan. "With over two and a half million gingival graft procedures being performed annually and millions of others that require this type of intervention, this was a product that the market was demanding. Our initial feedback has been very positive, especially with the periodontists who have used the product."

The latest HemCon Dental Dressing measures 1" x 3" and, when placed on an oral wound, adheres to the tissue, protecting it and providing pain relief. The bandage is designed to dissolve within seven days.

"The HemCon Dental Dressing was very impressive during our testing," said Dr. Robert Woolf, clinical investigator. "The dressing provided protection of the wound site and quickly stopped any bleeding."
